1860: Theodor Herzl, founder of modern Zionism, was born in Hungary

2000: The U.S announced that accurate GPS access, originally restricted to the U.S. military, would be made available for civilian use

2003: India and Pakistan restored diplomatic relations, broken off after an attack on the Indian parliament in 2001

2011: Al Qaeda leader Osama bin Laden was killed by U.S. special forces in Pakistan
