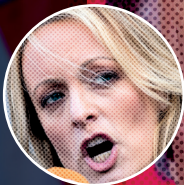


Donald Trump's legal troubles

Donald Trump has become the first former U.S. president to face criminal charges in a court of law

Apr 4, 2023: Trump charged with 34 felony counts of falsifying business records regarding alleged hush-money payments to porn star **Stormy Daniels** (right) and another woman




GEORGIA

 Special grand jury recently concluded investigation into Trump's alleged efforts to overturn 2020 presidential election defeat in Georgia. **Nearly 20 people directly investigated, including Trump's former personal lawyer Rudolph Giuliani** (top right), **could face charges**

Decision by Fulton County district attorney **Fani Willis** (right) on what charges to seek, expected by May




CAPITOL RIOT

 Congressional committee investigating Jan 6, 2021, assault by Trump supporters on U.S. Capitol urged Justice Department to charge Trump with inciting insurrection and other crimes

Separate criminal probe by Justice Department has already led to nearly 1,000 people who took part in assault being charged. **Trump could be called for questioning**

MAR-A-LAGO

 Justice Department looking into whether Trump improperly retained classified records after leaving office in 2021 and then tried to obstruct federal investigation

In August, FBI seized around 100 documents marked as classified from Trump's Florida estate of **Mar-a-Lago**. **Trump's team locked in legal battle with Justice Department over investigation**



NEW YORK

 In lawsuit in September, New York Attorney General **Letitia James** (left) accused Trump family of inflating their net worth by billions. James is seeking to bar Trump and his children from running businesses in New York again

New York judge has ordered independent monitor to oversee Trump Organization before scheduled October trial
