

# What the leaked Pentagon documents say

The online leak of highly secret U.S. documents – including sensitive information about the war in Ukraine – is a “very serious” risk to national security, the Pentagon says



## Ukraine

Details about Ukrainian air strikes, Kyiv's air defence vulnerabilities and size of some Ukrainian military units



## Canada

Suggestion that pro-Russian hackers disrupted operations at Canadian natural gas pipeline network in Feb 2023



## Middle East

Updates on Iran's nuclear activities and information about deepening ties between UAE and Russia



## Russia

Evidence of extensive U.S. spying on Russian security and intelligence services – raising concerns that Moscow might better conceal its planning



## Israel: Claim

that senior leaders of Mossad spy service encouraged demonstrations against Israeli government's proposed judicial reforms



## North Korea

Details about Pyongyang's missile tests and assessment that Feb 2023 parade likely oversold North Korea's ICBM threat to U.S.



## China

Predictions about how China would respond to Ukrainian strikes inside Russia, along with details about British plans in Indo-Pacific region



## South Korea

Disclosure of concerns in Seoul over U.S. pressure to send ammunition to Ukraine and South Korea's policy of not arming countries at war



## Wagner Group

Description of efforts by Russian mercenary organisation to buy arms from Turkey and expand its presence in Africa and Haiti
