May 10, 1960

▲ **The U.S. nuclear-powered submarine Triton became the first vessel to circumnavigate the world while submerged. The undersea voyage took 84 days**

1933: Nazis gathered in Berlin to burn “un-German” books by Karl Marx, Sigmund Freud and others

1975: Sony introduced the Betamax videocassette recorder (VCR). It was soon outstripped by JVC’s rival VHS

1998: Sinn Féin party members voted to accept the Good Friday agreement and join the Northern Ireland Assembly

2000: Microsoft offered to allow other browsers and software to be installed with its Windows system
