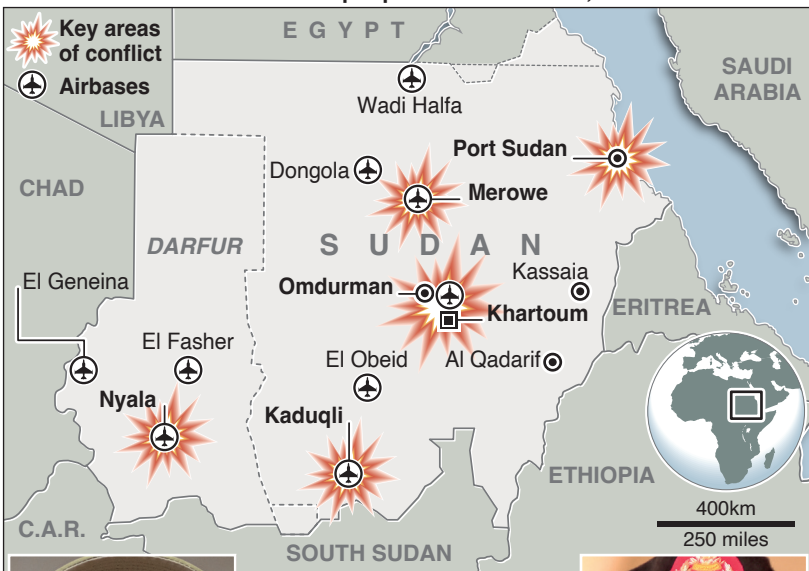


Fighting continues in Sudan

Intense clashes between Sudan's military and the powerful paramilitary group, the Rapid Support Forces (RSF), have claimed the lives of at least 296 people and wounded 3,000



■ **Apr 11:** Deadline to transfer power from military to civilian government missed

■ **Apr 15:** Fighting erupts in Sudanese capital Khartoum between RSF, under leadership of **Mohammed Hamdan Dagalo**, also known as **Hemedti** (left) and Sudanese Armed Forces (SAF), led by General **Abdel Fattah al-Burhan** (right)



■ **Apr 15-17:** Clashes between RSF and SAF spread throughout Sudan, with RSF attacks on airbases at Nyala in South Darfur, Kaduqli, Merowe and in Port Sudan

■ **Apr 18-19:** Fighting continues despite two 24-hour ceasefires – 16 hospitals, including nine in Khartoum, shut down. **Airbase attacks continue to neutralise SAF air power**
