▲ A 35,000 year-old wolf bone found in Siberia, with DNA split between dog and wolf, suggested the domestication of dogs began earlier than previously thought

1923: The International Congress of Dancing Masters condemned the Foxtrot and the Tango

1932: Amelia Earhart became the first woman to fly the Atlantic solo

1973: A British gunboat chased an Icelandic frigate in the first Royal Navy action of the "Cod War"

2008: Pakistan's North-West Frontier province agreed to withdraw troops and introduce Sharia law in the Swat Valley to halt Taliban attacks
