# Today in History

*May 22, 2003*

▲ **Annika Sorenstam, the top ranked women's golfer, became the first woman to compete in a men's PGA tour event for 59 years, but failed to make the cut**

**1943:** COMINTERM, a Soviet-controlled organization advocating world communism, was dissolved

**1998:** Voters on both sides of the Irish border gave strong support to the Good Friday peace agreement

**2003:** A unanimous UN Security Council resolution lifted sanctions on Iraq imposed after the 1991 Gulf War

**2003:** A manuscript of Beethoven's Ninth Symphony, with handwritten revisions, sold for £2.133m in London
