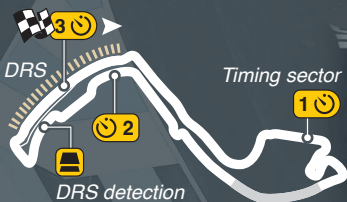


# Monaco Grand Prix
