▲ **Andy Murray became the first British player in 77 years to win the Wimbledon men's singles championship. He beat top seed Novak Djokovic in straight sets**

**1853:** Japan opened up to trade after more than 200 years of isolation

**1948:** The first Farnborough Airshow was held in Britain

**2003:** Iran confirmed it had successfully tested a mid-range missile, bringing Israel and U.S. troops stationed in Saudi Arabia within range

**2022:** UK Prime Minister Boris Johnson agreed to step down after mass resignations in parliament over his leadership
