▲ Zimbabwe introduced a new 100-billion dollar bank note in a bid to tackle rampant cash shortages as inflation hit a record 2.2 million percent

1973: France began a series of nuclear tests on the Mururoa Atoll in the Pacific

2008: Former Bosnian Serb leader Radovan Karadzic was arrested in Serbia after 12 years on the run

2008: Russia and China signed a pact agreeing their 4,300km border, after 40 years of negotiations

2011: The shuttle Atlantis touched down at the Kennedy Space Centre after the 135th and final flight of NASA's space shuttle programme
