*July 27, 1953*

▲ The armistice ending the three-year Korean War was signed at Panmunjom. The conflict claimed the lives of at least 2.5 million soldiers and civilians

**1054:** Macbeth, king of Scotland immortalised in Shakespeare's play, was defeated at Dunsinane

**1993:** Bosnian Serb, Croat and Muslim leaders met to press rival plans for the division of Bosnia

**2003:** U.S. teenager Michael Phelps, 18, set five world records at the world championships in Barcelona, Spain

**2013:** The first Przewalski's horse, a wild horse extinct in the wild, was born via artificial insemination
