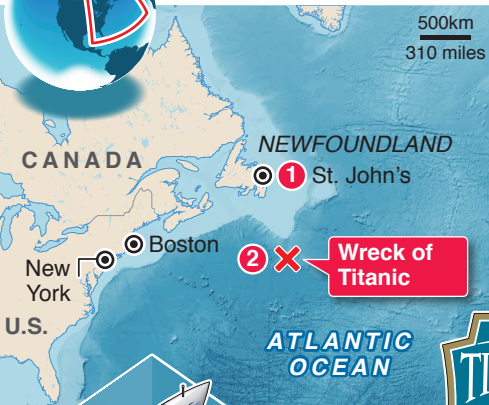


Race against time to find Titan submersible

Rescuers face a race against time to find the missing submersible exploring the wreck of the Titanic as its oxygen supply dwindles

TIMELINE

- 1 Jun 16:** Canadian research vessel **MV Polar Prince** sets sail
- 2 Jun 18:** Ship arrives near Titanic site
 - Crew locked inside. Hatch sealed from outside with 17 bolts
- 3 04:00 local time:** Dive begins
- 4 05:45:** Polar Prince loses contact with Titan
- Jun 19:** U.S. Coast Guard confirms sub has been missing for more than 24 hours

Titanic sank in April 1912 after hitting iceberg. Wreck lies around 3,800m deep

TITAN: World's only crewed submersible able to take five people as deep as 4,000m

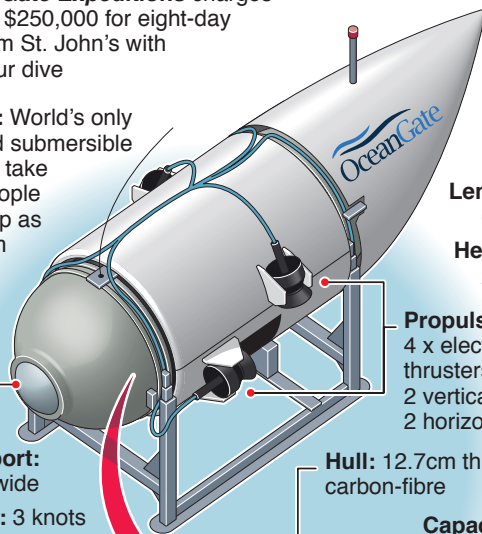
View port: 53cm wide

Speed: 3 knots

Weight: 10.4 tonnes

Private toilet

Caps: Titanium



Length: 6.7m

Propulsion: 4 x electric thrusters. 2 vertical, 2 horizontal

Jun 20, 13:00: U.S. Coast Guard estimates sub has only 40 hours of oxygen left, based on initial reports of 96 hours
