

IndiGo reaches for the sky

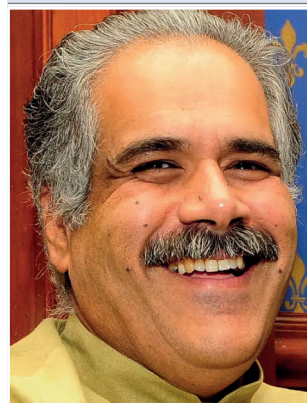


Airbus A321neoXLR

Range: 4,700nm (8,704km)

- **Jul 2006:** **Rahul Bhatia** (below left) and **Rakesh Gangwal** (centre) launch **IndiGo** budget airline
- IndiGo had placed order for 100 Airbus A320-200 aircraft worth US\$6 billion at 2005 Paris Air Show

- **Feb 2012:** Takes delivery of its 50th aircraft
- **Aug 2015:** IndiGo places order for 250 Airbus A320neo aircraft worth \$27 billion – largest single order ever in Airbus history



- **Dec 2019:** With fleet size of more than 250 aircraft, IndiGo becomes India's largest carrier

- **Jun 2022:** IndiGo appoints **Pieter Elbers** (right) – former chief executive officer of KLM Royal Dutch Airlines – as its new CEO

- **May 2023:** Economic boom spurs demand for domestic air travel – Indian airlines carry 132.14 million passengers with annual growth of 36.10%



- **2006:** Airline receives its first A320
- **2011:** IndiGo orders 180 Airbus A320 aircraft in deal worth \$15 billion

- **Jun 19, Paris Air Show:** IndiGo orders 500 single-aisle Airbus A320neo and A321XLR jets – single largest order in commercial aviation history

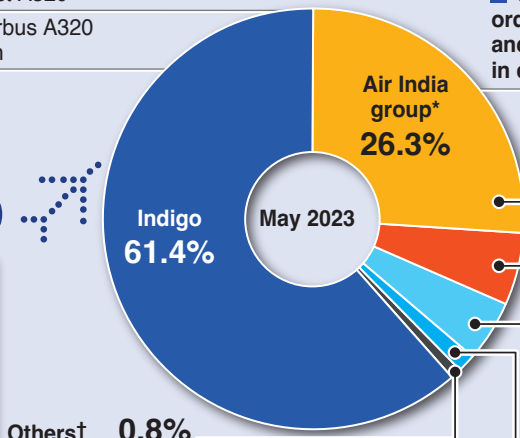
