Russian tycoon Alexei Mordashov's \$500 million superyacht is headed for his homeland after more than a year criss-crossing oceans and avoiding sanctions

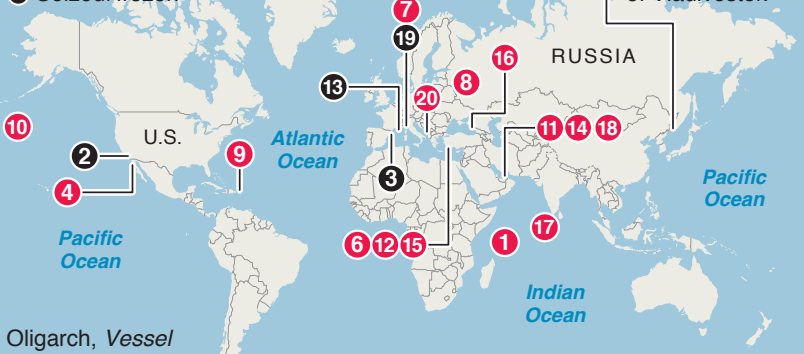
