

Spain's far-right to play election kingmaker?

Polls suggest the conservative People's Party will win more votes than the ruling Socialists in the general election, but will need the help of the far-right Vox party to form a government

Centre-right party of **Alberto Núñez Feijóo**



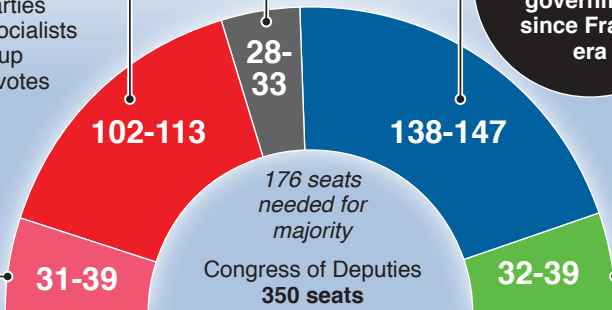
Sumar: Coalition of far-left and green parties hopes Socialists will pick up enough votes to keep PP and Vox out of power
