

# Drones hit Moscow business district

A second drone strike in two days has attacked a skyscraper in the heart of Moscow's financial district, reminding Russians that Ukrainian-made drones are capable of striking Russia's capital

■ **Jul 30:** Drone hits IQ-Quarter building – home to economic development ministry – in Moskva-City business district

■ **Aug 1:** Drone hits same tower

■ **Jun 21:** Three drones downed near base of Russia's 2nd Guards Motor Rifle Division in Moscow's Lukino region

■ **May 30:** At least three residential buildings in Moscow damaged in drone attacks

■ **May 3:** Two drones explode over dome of Senate inside Kremlin walls
