

Trump's criminal cases

Former U.S. President Donald Trump faces three criminal cases over falsifying business records, illegally hoarding classified documents and plotting to overthrow the 2020 election result



Justice Department: Trump faces 78 criminal counts in total, and may be indicted in separate case in Georgia



2020 election result

Federal prosecutors led by special counsel **Jack Smith** (left) accuse Trump of plotting to overturn election result, leading to Jan 6 Capitol riot.



Six co-conspirators allegedly helped Trump

Classified documents

Smith's prosecutors accuse Trump of violating Espionage Act by illegally holding classified documents at his Mar-a-Lago residence.



Indictment charges Trump and two others with conspiracy to obstruct attempts to recover documents

Hush money

Manhattan district attorney **Alvin L. Bragg** (centre), accuses Trump of falsifying business records following \$130,000 payment to **Stormy Daniels** on eve of 2016 election. **Trump charged with violating election laws by claiming payment as legal expense**



Georgia votes

Fulton County district attorney **Fani T. Willis** (right), is probing allegations that Trump pressured **Brad Raffensperger**, Georgia's secretary of state, to "find 11,780 votes," to win state
