Former security minister represents opposition centre-right coalition. Pledges tough austerity measures to stabilise economy and tough-on-crime approach to law and order

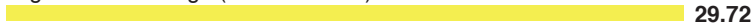
Liberal economist backed by voters tired of political status quo. Proposes to dollarise economy, shutter central bank and scrap some ministries to shrink state
