September 14, 1837

▲ **Charles Lewis Tiffany opened his first jewellery store in New York City, with first-day sales of \$4.98. In 2018, net sales at Tiffany & Co. totalled \$4.44 billion**

1901: Theodore Roosevelt became U.S. President after President William McKinley was assassinated

1975: Rembrandt's painting *The Nightwatch* was slashed with a knife at Amsterdam's Rijksmuseum

2010: A bill banning the wearing of the Islamic full face veil in public was approved in France

2015: At least five European countries reintroduced border controls as the migrant crisis intensified
