

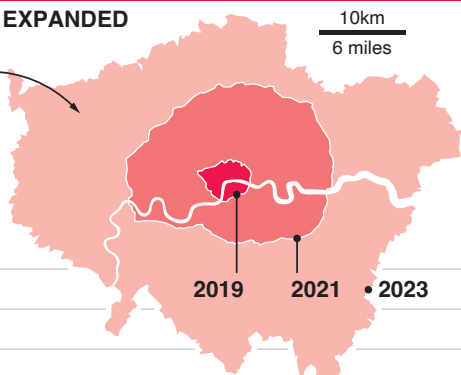
London's clean air zone expansion

Drivers of the most polluting vehicles must now pay a fee to enter any part of Britain's capital city, under an expansion of the contentious **Ultra Low Emission Zone (ULEZ)**

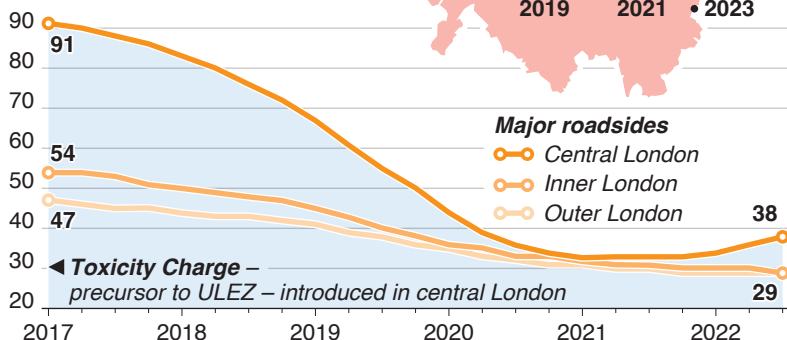

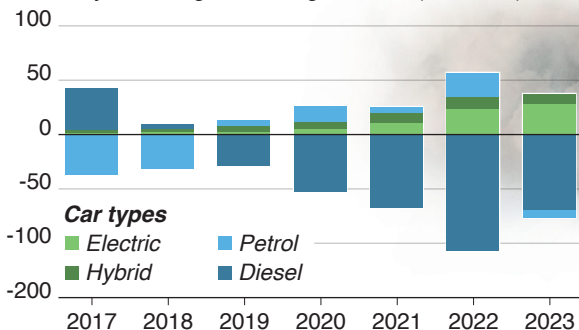
NO₂ CONCENTRATIONS
