Today in History

September 27, 1960

▲ **Europe's first moving walkway opened at Bank Underground station in London, six years after the first U.S. version was installed at a station in New Jersey**

1938: The Queen Elizabeth, at the time the largest passenger ship ever built, was launched at Clydebank in Scotland

1998: Gerhard Schroeder became Chancellor of Germany, ending the 16-year rule of Helmut Kohl

2008: Zhai Zhigang carried out China's first spacewalk during the Shenzhou 7 mission. It lasted 22 minutes

2020: The New York Times reported that Donald Trump had paid no federal income tax in 11 of the last 15 years
