▲ **American automobile pioneer Henry Ford introduced a moving assembly line into his plants to speed up mass production of the popular Model T car**

1883: German psychiatrist Emil Kraepelin developed a classification system for mental illness, distinguishing between treatable and untreatable disorders

1919: KLM, the national airline of the Netherlands and the world's oldest existing airline, was founded

1963: U.S. President John F. Kennedy signed the Nuclear Test Ban Treaty

2009: A vast new ring was identified around Saturn
