

Thousands feared dead in Libya floods

More than 3,000 people are believed to have died and 10,000 are missing after Storm Daniel caused devastating floods that swept away entire neighbourhoods in eastern Libya

○ Cities and towns most affected by flooding

○ Oil ports subject to temporary closure

Derna: Much of city under water after two dams and four bridges collapsed. At least 700 people confirmed dead and 1,200 injured
