▲ **A massive explosion damaged the Kerch Strait bridge, the vital military and civilian supply link between mainland Russia and occupied Crimea**

1953: The U.S. and Britain withdrew troops from the Free Territory of Trieste, handing control to Italy

1973: LBC (London Broadcasting Corporation) became the first legal commercial radio station in Britain

1993: The UN lifted its last economic sanctions against South Africa, imposed because of racial apartheid

1998: The U.S. House of Representatives voted to begin impeachment hearings against President Bill Clinton
