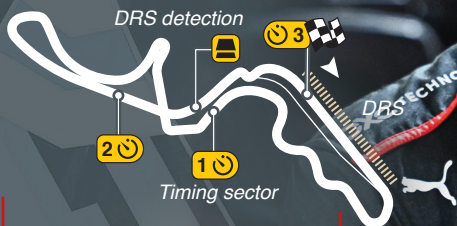


Japanese Grand Prix
