

# Detainees freed in U.S.-Iran prisoner swap

The United States and Iran have each freed five detainees under an exchange agreement that also involved the transfer of \$6 billion in Iranian assets previously frozen in South Korea


**Siamak Namazi**  
U.S.-Iranian businessman detained in 2015 by Revolutionary Guards while visiting his family in Tehran



**Morad Tahbaz**  
British-born conservationist arrested in 2018 during Iranian crackdown on environmental activists



**Emad Shargi**  
U.S.-Iranian businessman arrested in 2018 but bailed after eight months. Detained again in 2021




Two detainees – including one female former UN worker – wish to remain anonymous

Convicted in 2021 for his role in scheme to obtain military parts for Iran




**Kambiz Kashani**  
Sentenced in Feb 2023 for conspiring to illegally export U.S. technology



**Reza Kafrani**  
Charged in 2021 with unlawful export of laboratory equipment to Iran



**Amin Hassanzadeh**  
Charged in 2019 over alleged theft of sensitive technical data



**Kaveh Afrasiabi**  
Arrested in 2021 on charges that he acted as unregistered foreign agent
