▲ **Commemorative poppies were first worn at Britain's annual Remembrance Day ceremony to raise money for soldiers wounded in the First World War**

1675: German mathematician Gottfried Leibniz demonstrated integral calculus for the first time

1926: Route 66, running 2,448 miles (3,940km) from Chicago to Los Angeles through eight U.S. states, was established

1952: The first video recorder was demonstrated in the United States

2008: Egypt announced the discovery of a 4,300-year-old pyramid belonging to Queen Sesheshet
