▲ A state funeral for assassinated U.S. President John F. Kennedy took place, before his burial with full military honours at Arlington National Cemetery

1621: Tradition has it that the first harvest Thanksgiving was shared by colonists and the Native Americans

1973: Greek dictator Colonel George Papadopoulos was overthrown by rival officers in a bloodless coup

2008: Anti-government protesters in Thailand closed down Bangkok's Suvarnabhumi Airport

2018: Russian forces seized three Ukrainian naval ships in the disputed Kerch Strait
