November 26, 1940

▲ **The Warsaw Ghetto was walled off, sealing in more than 400,000 Jewish residents, many of whom were subsequently deported to Nazi extermination camps**

1504: Queen Isabella of Castile, whose marriage to Ferdinand of Aragon led to the political unification of Spain, died

1939: Rock diva Tina Turner was born in Nutbush, Tennessee

1983: £26 million worth of gold bullion was stolen from a security warehouse at Heathrow Airport in one of Britain's biggest ever robberies

1993: Iraq agreed to long-term monitoring of its arms potential to try to persuade the UN to lift sanctions
