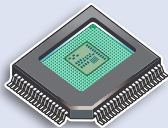


Weapons from Iran, North Korea

Russia has enlisted Iran and North Korea to provide weapons for its ongoing assault on Ukraine. President Vladimir Putin has even built a factory to construct thousands of Iranian-designed drones

IRAN: Shahed-136 (Geran-2): Iranian self-detonating attack drone

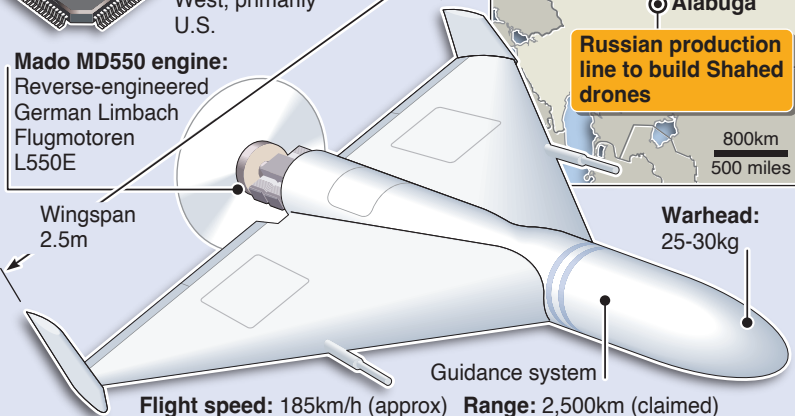


Electronics: Over 90% of drone's computer chips are manufactured in West, primarily U.S.

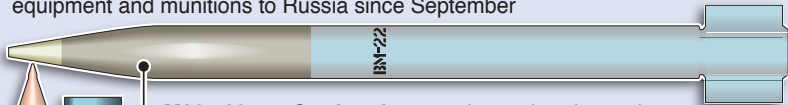

9M22 122mm Grad rocket: 18.4kg warhead contains TGAF-5 explosive, comprising TNT, RDX and aluminium powder

122mm and 152mm artillery rounds: Heavy shelling of Ukraine has led to Russia's shortage of artillery shells

North Korea's Soviet-era ammunition: Includes high-explosive, armour-piercing, HEAT (high-explosive anti-tank), fragmentation, and chemical warheads
