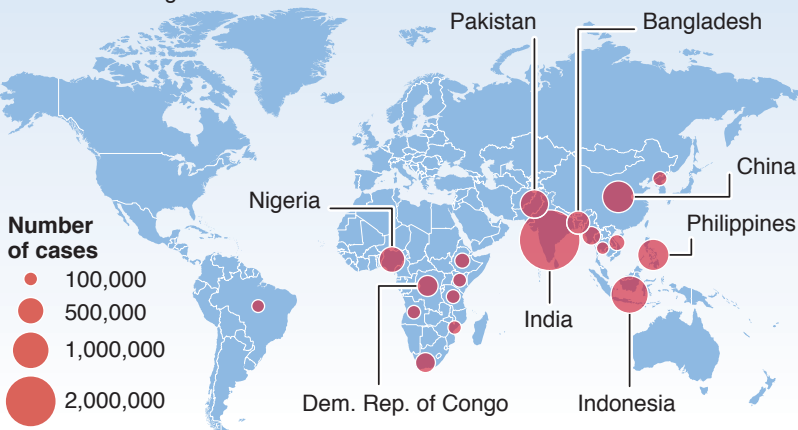


Global impact of tuberculosis

Tuberculosis (TB), which is preventable and curable, remains one of the world's leading infectious disease killers, despite new medicines and better diagnostic tools

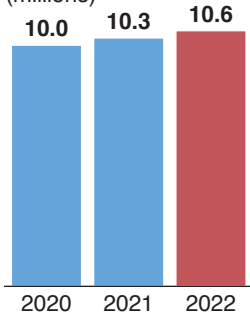
TB BURDEN: Eight countries accounted for 68% of total cases in 2022

DISEASE OVERVIEW: TB caused by bacteria, commonly affects lungs

■ Spread through air when people with lung TB cough, sneeze or spit

■ Leading cause of death of people with HIV and major contributor to antimicrobial resistance

■ 25% of global population infected with TB bacteria. Only 5-10% of those will become sick or infectious during their lifetime
