▲ A landmark deal to try to limit the rise in global temperatures to less than 2°C was agreed at the conclusion of the COP21 climate change summit in Paris

1963: Kenya won independence from Britain; it became a republic in 1964 with Jomo Kenyatta as president

2003: Canadian prime minister Jean Chretien stepped down after 10 years
