

Gaza hospitals caught in crossfire

Key health facilities in northern Gaza have been damaged in the intense fighting and only a handful remain operational

AL SHIFA HOSPITAL

■ Gaza's largest hospital, with 700 beds, has run out of fuel and "ceased to function", WHO says

■ Some **2,300** people – **650** patients, **200-500** staff and around **1,500** people seeking shelter – are trapped inside

■ Doctors say several newborn babies and patients have died

AL QUDS HOSPITAL

■ Second largest hospital no longer operational

■ Evacuations planned for **6,000** patients, medics and displaced people

AL RANTISI, 4. AL NASR

■ **Rantisi** children's hospital – with Gaza's only paediatric cancer ward – and **Al Nasr** hospital mostly evacuated

■ Patients in worst condition sent to Al Shifa, others directed to southern Gaza

AL SWEIDI CLINIC

■ Swedish clinic sheltering 500 people destroyed by air strike, UN says.

Casualty toll unclear

INDONESIA HOSPITAL

■ Damaged and running out of fuel but still operational
