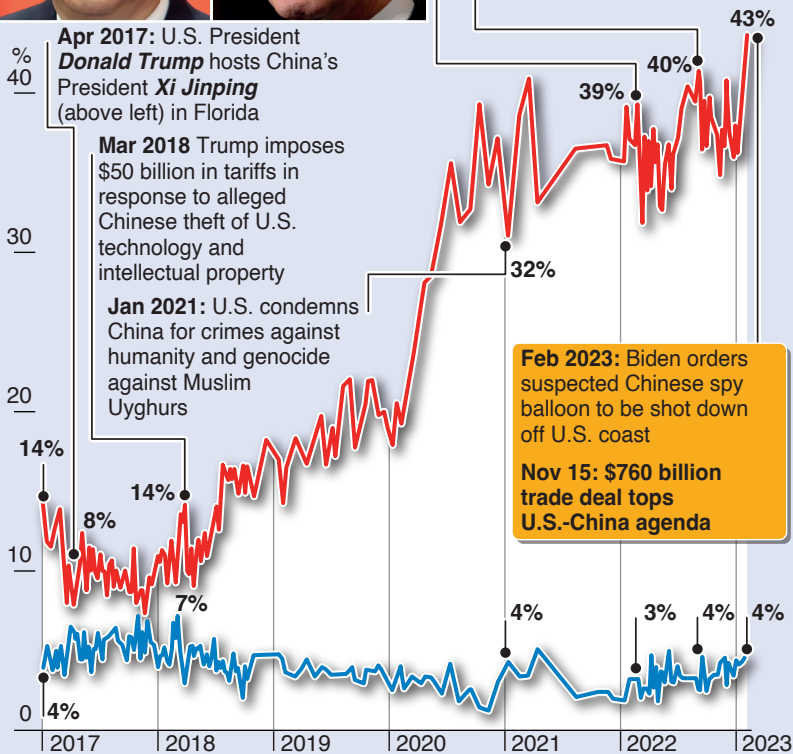
**Feb 2022:** President **Joe Biden** (left) boycotts Beijing Olympics

**Feb 2023:** Biden orders suspected Chinese spy balloon to be shot down off U.S. coast

**Nov 15:** \$760 billion trade deal tops U.S.-China agenda
