December 19, 1903

▲ **The Williamsburg suspension bridge, connecting Brooklyn and Manhattan, opened in New York. Until 1924 it was the world's longest suspension bridge**

1793: Napoleon Bonaparte recaptured Toulon and forced the Anglo-Spanish fleet to withdraw

1998: U.S. President Bill Clinton was impeached on two counts of perjury and obstruction of justice

1999: China resumed sovereignty over the territory of Macau after 442 years of Portuguese colonial rule

2003: Libya agreed to abandon efforts to develop nuclear, biological and chemical weapons
