January 7, 1610

▲ **Italian astronomer Galileo Galilei first sighted Jupiter's four largest satellite moons, using the telescope he had developed the previous year**

1895: China recognized the independence of Korea at the end of the First Sino-Japanese War

1904: The shipping distress call CQD (seek you, danger) was introduced. It was later replaced by SOS

1979: Vietnamese forces and Cambodian rebels captured Phnom Penh and ousted the Khmer Rouge

2010: The United States approved arms sales to Taiwan, despite opposition from China
