

# Mass shootings in Europe

*Candles lit for victims of Czech Republic's worst gun attack*



**1 Dec 2023, Czech Rep:** 24-year-old Czech student shoots dead his father and 14 people at his Prague university before killing himself

**2 May 2023, Serbia:** 13-year-old student at Belgrade school kills nine fellow pupils and one security guard. Next day 20-year-old man kills eight in village south of capital

**3 Mar 2023, Germany:** Gunman in Hamburg shoots dead six people and one unborn child before killing himself at a Jehovah's Witness Kingdom Hall

**4 Jul 2016, Germany:** 18-year-old German-Iranian man kills nine people and then himself at restaurant in shopping mall in Munich

**5 Nov 2015, France:** Islamist attackers in Paris armed with guns and bombs target concert hall, sports stadium, restaurants and bars, killing 130 people

**6 Jul 2011, Norway:** Neo-Nazi terrorist kills eight people with car bomb in Oslo before shooting dead 69 people, most of them teenagers, at summer youth camp

**7 Apr 2011, Netherlands:** 24-year-old gunman goes on shooting rampage at shopping centre in town south of Amsterdam, killing six before turning gun on himself

**8 Aug 2010, Slovakia:** Gunman shoots dead six members of Roma family and another woman in Bratislava before killing himself

**9 Jun 2010, UK:** Taxi driver shoots dead 12 people in towns across rural county of Cumbria. He then kills himself

**10 Mar 2009, Germany:** 17-year-old kills 15 people, including nine students at school, in town north of Stuttgart. He is later killed in shoot-out with police
