▲ **USS Nautilus, the world's first nuclear-powered submarine, was launched. Her many records included the first submerged transit of the North Pole in 1958**

1793: Louis XVI was beheaded on the guillotine after being overthrown in the French Revolution and tried for treason

1924: Vladimir Ilyich Lenin, who led the Bolsheviks to victory in Russia's October Revolution, died

1976: Supersonic passenger travel began as the first scheduled flights on Concorde took off

2004: The daughter of Norway's Crown Prince became the first female in six centuries in line to the throne
