1945: The U.S. city of Grand Rapids became the first to add fluoride to its drinking water to reduce tooth decay

1954: Dylan Thomas's radio drama *Under Milk Wood* was first broadcast in Britain

2006: The militant Islamic group Hamas won a surprise victory in the Palestinian parliamentary election

2023: Germany announced they would send tanks to Ukraine to boost the war effort
