▲ The Mumbai Monorail, India's first monorail since independence, was officially inaugurated. Around 20,000 people queued to use it on its first day of operation

1944: DNA was accidentally identified as the hereditary agent in a virus by scientists monitoring pneumonia

1949: The RCA record company released the first 45 rpm single

1999: Monica Lewinsky was formally questioned during the impeachment trial of President Bill Clinton
