

Pakistan launches retaliatory strikes into Iran

Pakistan has conducted missile strikes inside Iran, targeting separatist Baloch militants, two days after Tehran said it had attacked the bases of another group within Pakistani territory



Jan 18: Several missiles hit targets around city of Saravan, killing at least nine people, Iran says.

Strikes hit “terrorist hideouts” used by two militant groups seeking Balochi independence, Pakistan says

Jan 16: Missile and drone strikes hit village of Koh-e-Sabz, killing two children, Pakistan says.

Strikes hit camps belonging to ***Jaish al-Adl*** – Sunni group with similar separatist goals, Iran says
