Icon of the Seas, the world's largest cruise ship, has arrived in her homeport of Miami ahead of her departure on her maiden voyage

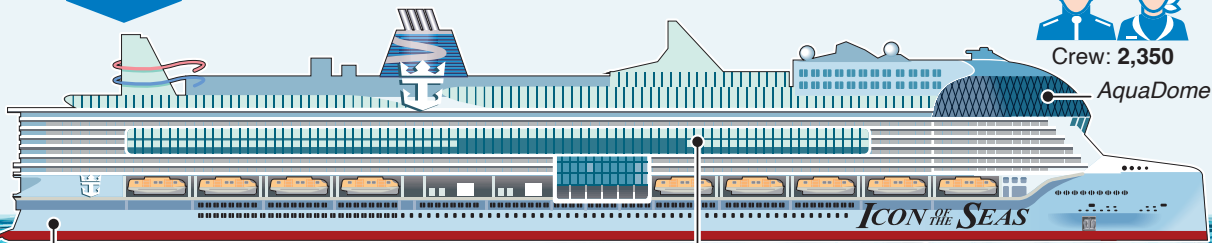

■ Built at Finland's **Meyer Turku** shipyard

- Vessel powered by six dual-fuel engines with ability to use diesel or liquefied natural gas (LNG)
- Public areas of Icon comprise eight neighbourhoods and five new "adventures," including **AquaDome** – geodesic dome with 600 panels of glass

■ Decks: 20

18 guest decks offer 2,805 staterooms with 28 different cabin categories

■ Air lubrication system:

Hull coated with microscopic bubbles to reduce friction

■ Gross tonnage: 250,800

■ **RMS Titanic:** Built in 1912, royal mail ship **Titanic** was then world's largest vessel. Decks: 7
