

U.S. military sales set new record

The U.S. government sold a record \$81 billion worth of military equipment and services to foreign powers in 2023 – an increase of 56% on 2022, the U.S. State Department reports

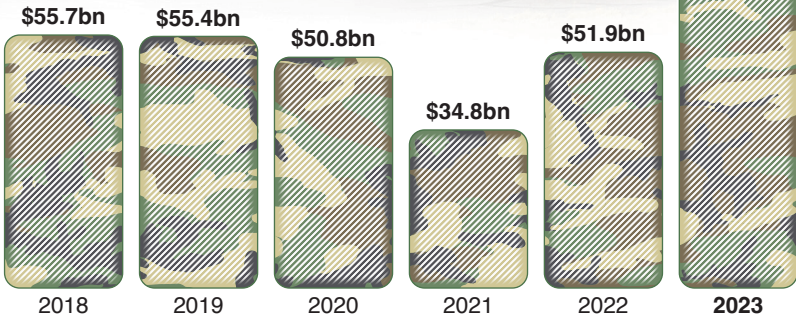
Ukraine's neighbour Poland was largest customer, spending over \$30bn on Apache attack helicopters, missile defence systems, and Abrams battle tanks
