▲ **Muhammad Ali, then known as Cassius Clay, won the world heavyweight boxing title for the first time after he knocked out Sonny Liston in Miami**

1954: Gamal Abdel Nasser became prime minister of Egypt

1964: Kim Il-sung of North Korea called for all cooperative farms to become state-run collectives

1994: The U.S. expelled Russian diplomat Aleksandr Iosifovich Lysenko, identified as Moscow's chief intelligence officer in Washington

2014: The largest Bitcoin exchange, Mt. Gox, announced it was filing for bankruptcy following a major theft
