▲ A series of devastating terror attacks on commuter trains in Madrid killed 191 people and injured over 1,500 during the morning rush hour

**105:** Chinese court official Ts'ai Lun is credited with inventing paper from dried tree bark, remnants of hemp and rags

**1999:** London's Wembley Stadium, famous for its twin towers, was sold for demolition to build a new stadium

**1999:** The IT company Infosys became the first Indian company to be listed on the NASDAQ stock exchange

**2011:** A magnitude 9.0 earthquake and tsunami struck Japan, triggering a major nuclear emergency
