▲ Chinese president Xi Jinping made a state visit to Russia in a show of support for President Vladimir Putin. It was Xi's first visit since the invasion of Ukraine

1927: Nationalist Chinese forces under Chiang Kai-shek captured Shanghai from the Chinese Communist Party

1994: Steven Spielberg collected his first Oscars, Best Director and Best Film, for *Schindler's List*

2006: Twitter, the online service enabling users to send 140-character messages called "tweets", was founded

2009: Up to 100,000 Italians marched through Naples calling for more police action against mafia clans
