▲ The Swedish band ABBA won the Eurovision Song Contest with the pop classic Waterloo, which was later voted the best song in the contest's history

1939: The “non-stick” polymer Teflon was accidentally discovered by researchers at Du Pont

2004: President Rolandas Paksas of Lithuania was impeached following claims of links to the Russian mafia

2009: A major earthquake in Italy killed 295 people in and around L'Aquila
