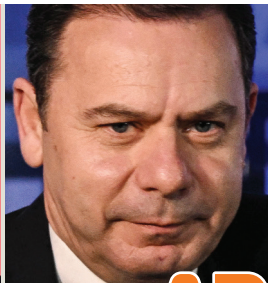
Another far-right populist party is on track to secure up to a fifth of the vote in Portugal's general election on March 10
