▲ The world's first cloned camel was born in Dubai. The calf, named Injaz (Achievement), made her debut alongside her surrogate mother five days after her birth

1984: Texas repealed a law requiring evolution to be taught as one of several theories, rather than as fact

1994: The government of Greece voted to strip former King Constantine of his Greek citizenship

2004: The U.S. backed Israeli prime minister Ariel Sharon's plan to withdraw Israeli settlements from Gaza

2023: The Jupiter Icy Moons Explorer (JUICE) was launched to study Jupiter's major moons
