

Trump's trials and tribulations

Former President Donald Trump is unable to raise an appeal bond to prevent New York's attorney general from seizing his real estate assets to satisfy a \$454 million civil fraud judgment

■ **Civil fraud case:** Judge **Arthur Engoron** levies **\$454m** penalty after concluding Trump fraudulently overvalued his Mar-a-Lago estate in Florida, his penthouse apartment in Manhattan, office buildings, and golf courses to obtain favourable loans



■ **Georgia election:** Fulton County District Attorney has charged Trump with spreading lies about voter fraud and urging lawmakers to reverse **Joe Biden's** win

■ **Mar 5:** Trump secures **\$91.6m** bond to prevent writer **E. Jean Carroll** (right), who accused Trump of rape in mid-2019, from enforcing defamation verdict during appeal



■ **Classified documents case:** Special counsel Jack Smith has accused Trump of taking highly sensitive national security documents when he left White House in January 2021. Trial is scheduled for May 20, but Trump-appointed judge overseeing case has indicated she will push date back



■ **Federal election interference:** Special counsel **Jack Smith** has charged Trump with four federal crimes stemming from his attempts to overturn 2020 election results, culminating in Jan 6, 2021, when mob of Trump supporters stormed Capitol Building

■ **Hush money case:** Trump is accused of falsifying business records in connection with \$130,000 payoff to porn star **Stormy Daniels** (right). Trial delayed from Mar 25 to mid-April
